

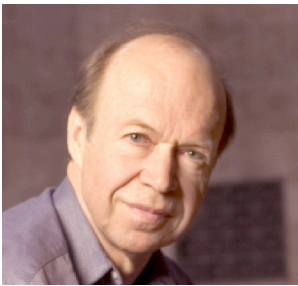
Welcome to the Call

The Guest Speaker on the call is Dr. James Hansen, a member of the National Academy of Sciences, on the Columbia University faculty, and Director of NASA's Goddard Institute for Space Studies. Dr. Hansen is the leading authority on the study of climate change. He will be speaking as a private citizen. He recently published his first book, "Storms of My Grandchildren." His predictions on climate change have been uncanny in their accuracy. He was one of the first to warn that carbon dioxide concentrations must be brought down to at most 350 parts per million to avoid the worst effects of climate change.



ACTIONS:

- 1) Invite as many people as possible to our Saturday, March 6th National Conference Call Meeting (see talking points on p. 2). Our Guest Speaker will be RESULTS Founder, Sam Daley-Harris. Sam is the world's leading expert on citizen lobbying. We will use this call as training for our National Show of Support Rallies during the March Congressional Recess, March 29th – April 9th. Designate a member of your Group to request a meeting with your member of the House or Senate during this recess. Give your Group Leader an update once a week on the progress of your inviting. Practice inviting people at least once before you leave the meeting.
- 2) Designate someone in the group to send the CCL press release on Monday to your local newspapers and TV regarding the call with Jim Hansen.

Talking points for inviting to March CCL meeting/conference call

- Guest speaker is Sam Daley-Harris, founder of RESULTS, the organization that provides the model of citizen activism for Citizens Climate Lobby.
- RESULTS' grassroots lobbying efforts introduced the concept of microcredit – loans for the poor – to the U.S. Congress and secured billions of dollars in funding for micro-lending programs throughout the world.
- In a polarized political atmosphere, this approach to advocacy shows us a way that we can break through partisan politics.
- The call this month will set the stage for a very powerful meeting we will have at the end of the month with our member of Congress to build support for the best possible climate legislation.
